CAMPOUT EQUIPMENT LIST & PERMISSION FORM

WHEN: February 9-11, 2007
WHERE: Beaumont Scout Reservation - Rock Creek, Ohio on Rt. 45 7 miles south of I-90
MEET: At Church at 7:00 PM Friday
RETURN DRIVERS: at camp by 9:15 AM Sunday **DROP OFF:** will be at homes around noon
COST: \$9 for food, \$5 for registration = TOTAL \$14

NOTE: Cooking will be by Troop (except for lunch)

EQUIPMENT REQUIRED: ITEMS MARKED "X" MUST BE BROUGHT UNLESS OK FROM SCOUTMASTER. Bring items marked "A" if available. "O" = optional.

MARK ALL GEAR WITH NAME AND TROOP NUMBER!!

CHECK WEATHER FORECAST!

WEAR:

X__ innermost layer to cover legs and torso -- wool or polyester
X__ two (2) insulation layers for legs and torso -- wool or polyester fleece
X__ wind-resistant outer layer for legs (such as nylon running pants or tightly woven trousers) and torso (coat or parka), preferably with hood. Avoid cotton if at all possible. Avoid Levis at all cost!
X__ caps or other winter hats to cover ears and back of neck
O__ scarf
X__ waterproof boots, preferably insulated (If not insulated, must allow multiple layers of socks without being tight.)
X__ wool, polyester or acrylic socks to fit boots
X__ poncho or raincoat
X__ gloves or mittens

EXTRA CLOTHING:

X__ Full Uniform for Sat night (w/beret)
X__ extra hat(s)
X__ socks, wool, polyester, or acrylic, three (3) extra sets (Nothing is more likely to get wet.)
X__ extra set of innermost layer (next to skin), legs and torso, polyester or wool
X__ extra briefs or boxers
X__ sweaters, fleece or substitute, wool or polyester, two (2)
X__ pajamas or sweat suit
O__ extra scarf or neck gaiter
X__ extra wind-resistant outer layer (See above)

X__ gloves and/or mittens, two (2) or more
X__ extra boots/shoes (If boots have a removable liner, an extra liner or extra socks to replace liner will suffice.)

OTHER

X__ bowl, cup & spoon
X__ personal first aid kit AND ANY REQUIRED PERSONAL MEDICATIONS
X__ flashlight & extra batteries
X__ ground cloth, waterproof
X__ matches in waterproof container
X__ toiletries, including small towel
X__ tooth brush and small paste
X__ water bottle or canteen
X__ plastic trash bags, three (3)
X__ toilet paper
X__ rope, ten (10) feet
X__ foam pad or foam-filled air mattress
X__ sleeping bag PLUS extra bag or blankets to provide for predicted temperatures
X__ dufflebag lined with plastic bag
X__ towel
X__ sun glasses (IF the sun comes out, glare off sun can produce sun blindness.)
A__ pocket knife if has TOT'N'CHIP
O__ camera
O__ chapstick
O__ handbook in plastic bag
O__ neckerchief
O__ wrist watch

SPECIAL INFORMATION REGARDING THIS OUTING: The annual klondike derby is a district-wide competition between patrols from many troops.
