SPECIAL INFORMATION REGARDING THIS OUTING: International camporee. Chance to meet 4,000 Scouts from Canada and other states to swap experiences, patches, songs, skits, etc. Scoutcraft competition, fun games, and display events. **Over 150 total events!!!** We will be traveling on a bus in full uniform. Make sure that your uniform is complete. Electronic games and radios will be permitted **on the bus only**, but must not make noise and absolutely must be marked with your name.

Important documentation required: All going must give their **(1)original birth certificate or passport.** Those without a passport also need to have a **(2) photo ID.** A driver's license or state ID card from the BMV is best. (If all else fails a school ID or recreational facility pass). If you are not a US citizen, please inform Rich Hoban by the time the permission is due. For non-citizens, a passport or visa will be necessary.

(3)The permission form is separate and needs to be signed by both parents (if applicable) and notarized.

(4) Scouts Canada medical form must be completed and returned for each scout. No scout or scouter will be permitted to depart on trip without proper documents submitted.

Sign and return to Rich Hoban, trip coordinator, as soon as possible. All forms and funds are due by **April 25, 2005 at the latest (WHICH IS A WEEK EARLIER THAN USUAL), by the beginning of meeting.**
