LOCATED: Camping at Camp Manidokan, Md. (about 5 miles from Harpers Ferry)
MEET: Friday at 7:45 A.M. at St. Paul's Church auxiliary parking lot
DROP OFF: Sunday at 4:00 P.M. at St. Paul's Church auxiliary parking lot
COST: \$60 per person (includes \$14 food, \$5 camp fee and bus/van rental)

NOTE: Cooking will be by Patrols.
