Procedure Signals

Used by **SENDER** (Letters with line over them sent as one letter)

Morse	Sampohere	Meaning	Explanation
AAAA	Attention	Attention	I have a message for you. Are you ready?
8 Es	8 Es	Error	I made a mistake. I will repeat beginning with last word that I sent correctly.
Front or Pause	Front	End of word	End of word. More coming. (Front with flag; pause in other methods.)
AAA	AAA	Period	End of sentence. More coming. (Punctuation is usually spelled out in long messages.)
AR	AR	End of message	That's all for now; did you get it?

Used by **RECEIVER** (Letters with line over them sent as one letter)

Morse	Sampohere	Meaning	Explanation
K	K	Go ahead	I am ready to receive. Start sending.
IMI	IMI	Repeat sign	Please send again; I missed it.
T	C	Word received	I understand word. TO BE SENT UPON RECEIPT OF EACH WORD (not used in telegraph and radio receiving).
R	R	Message received	I got it OK.
