Campsite Selection Criteria

The following factors should be considered in selecting a campsite. Weighting of individual factors varies from situation to situation, but no site should be selected that is inconsistent with the program that is the reason for the outing.

- 1. Suitability for program
- 2. Health, safety and security
- 3. Privacy
- 4. Availability of tent sites (level ground)
- 5. Suitability for camping in inclement weather (drainage; wind protection)
- 6. Availability of safe water
- 7. Availability of firewood
- 8. Scenic features
- 9. Cost
- 10. Distance
- 11. Parking
- 12. able to reserve in advance
- 13. Shelter
- 14. Working toilet
