Jonathan Snyder

A native of the Cleveland area, Jonathan joined Cub Scout Pack 11 while attending Fairfax Elementary School. In 1984, as a Webelo Scout he crossed into Troop 83 that was sponsored by the Church of Saviour. Troop 83, led by To Linton, merged with Troop 22 in 1986. Jonathan served the Troop as Assistant Patrol Leader then Patrol Leader of the Indian Patrol, and Assistant Senior Patrol Leader. Jonathan's Eagle Project was the raising of over \$800 for Northeast Ohio Coalition for the Homeless by recruiting volunteers to participate in a walk-a-thon after collecting pledges. Throughout his tenure in Scouts, Jonathan was involved in the Heights High School Symphonic Winds and Jazz Ensemble, National Honor Society, and Academic Decathlon. Since graduating from Cleveland Heights High School in 1991, he has continued his education at The University of Pennsylvania in Philadelphia.

Michael Dudley Battle

In 1984 Dudley Battle crossed over to Troop 83 after a fun-filled Cub Scout career with Pack 11. Dudley stayed in Troop 83 until the group merged with Troop 22 in 1986. In Troop 22 Dudley became the Patrol Leader of the Wolf Patrol, later the Flaming Wolf Patrol. One highlight of Dudley's Career as Patrol Leader was the Wolf Patrol first place victory in the 1987 District Klondike Derby. After becoming Assistant Senior Patrol Leader, Dudley returned to the position of Patrol Leader of the new Flaming Wolf Patrol. This was Troop 22's first experiment into forming a patrol exclusively from Webelo Scouts. In 1990 Dudley was elected to serve as the Senior Patrol Leader. Dudley's Eagle project involved service to St. Paul's Episcopal Church, the new home of the Troop. Dudley's extensive High Adventure experiences include; canoeing at Tinnerman and on the Mattawa River, and backpacking in West Virginia, Philmont and the White Mountains.

Dudley is a 1991 graduate of Cleveland Heights High School where Tennis, Wrestling, Marching Band, the National Honor Society, and the Academic Decathlon were among his activities. Dudley is a Freshman at Bates College in Lewiston, Maine.
